# **VPH Livestock Dropoff Agreement**

We at Vermont Packinghouse do everything we can to ensure the comfort and safety of the animals brought here. When delivering livestock, please respect the following:

#### **GENERAL EXPECTATIONS**

- VPH Employees are prohibited from entering ANY trailers.
- Affidavits must be presented at drop off if not provided beforehand.
  - Livestock must have adequate space to lie down.
    - Any cattle horns must be 4 inches or shorter.
    - All hogs must weigh less than 400 pounds.

## **HUMANE HANDLING EXPECTATIONS**

- Take proper precautions to avoid stress or suffering of the animals.
- Make sure untrained personnel or spectators do not disrupt the unloading process.
- Before unloading, make sure the trailer is positioned properly with the ramp (no measurable gaps).
  - Make sure animals are in good physical condition before unloading.
- During unloading, remain calm and minimize yelling/profanity, unnecessary noise, harassment, or force.
- Moving animals using feet or kicking is prohibited. Using boards or pushing with knees is acceptable.
  - Electric prods are a last resort and should only be used by authorized personnel, on beef only.
- Use of electric prods in extreme sensitive surfaces of the livestock (eyes, ears, anus, etc.) is STRICTLY PROHIBITED

## TRAILER ACCEPTANCE

- Trailers need to be ventilated in temperatures 80F and above.
- Trailers need to be closed and bedded in temperatures 20F and below.
- Trailers must be in generally good repair with no risks to animal wellbeing.

#### RECOMMENDED TRANSPORT SPACE

Requirements for pigs when running short trips under 3 hours.



### **DROP OFF TIME WINDOWS**

Call VPH before arriving with livestock if you have not been given a clear drop off time window or will arrive outside of that window. VPH will turn animals away if (1) you arrive outside of your time window, and we cannot fit them in our holding facility or (2) you arrive outside of our receiving hours. We must be very strict with our receiving hours. Be safe and arrive 1 hour before closing times. Sunday drops are only for previously approved haulers. Thank you for strictly respecting these times.

6:00 AM - 6:00 PM Monday - Thursday 6:00 AM - 12:00 PM Friday 12:00 PM - 6:00 PM Sunday



- Approach VPH only using Cider Mill Road, right on Giddings Street, left on Fairbanks Road
  Turn vehicle off once stopped on VPH property. No idling allowed.
- Use CALL BUTTON mounted on building next to the door to the left of the unloading area.
  - Deliver cut sheets to VPH staff upon unloading livestock. Or email ahead of time.
    - Please respect local speed limits.
